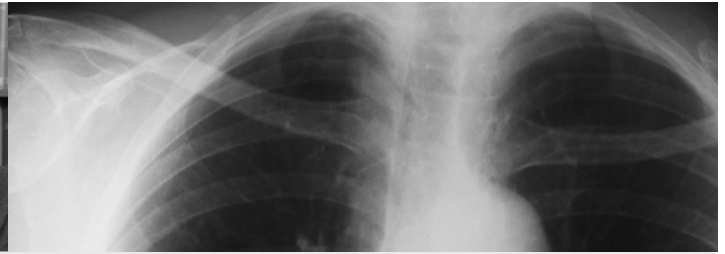

Dr. Fernando J. Martinez, MD, MS, is an internationally recognized clinical researcher in the field of pulmonary medicine. He received his MD from the University of Florida and his MS from the University of Michigan. He completed his residency training and pulmonary fellowship in Boston. Dr. Martinez is currently a Professor of Medicine at the University of Michigan. His research interests span the field of pulmonary medicine and his work has been supported in part through NIH grants in the areas of interstitial lung disease and obstructive lung disease. Dr. Martinez was one of the lead investigators in the landmark lung volume reduction surgery in COPD study through the National Emphysema Treatment Trial (NETT). Dr. Martinez has authored over 140 papers, reviews and chapters in his career and is a highly sought speaker in the field of clinical pulmonary medicine.
