

POLICY: Continued Online Education Requirements

PURPOSE: To ensure that educational training modules are completed by residents/fellows and faculty as required by UCSF Fresno and UCSF.

Online educational training modules have been established to contribute to the development of residents, fellows and faculty. UCSF Fresno has partnered with Med-IQ (formerly ELM Exchange), the leading provider of online healthcare risk management and patient safety education programs and resources, to offer access to the highest quality risk management continuing education courses. Residents and fellows are required to complete the Med-IQ online educational modules once every three (3) years from the time they begin training. Core faculty are required to complete online educational modules once every five (5) years. An email is sent out to trainees and faculty when it is time to complete these modules. The Graduate Medical Education office works with the program offices to track completions of online training. The following are the required training modules:

Med-IQ Modules: (these modules may be changed or updated annually but it will not affect the required completion dates. Each takes less than an hour, includes goals & objectives, an overview of principles, several case studies and a post-test. Courses can be stopped and restarted as needed. You will be asked to complete a short assessment prior to accessing the course units.

- Challenging Resident Paradigms
- Ethical Dilemmas: Unprofessional Behaviors
- Fatigue Management for the Resident Physician
- Informed Consent: Discussion & Documentation
- Professionalism for the Resident Physician
- Managing the Adolescent Patient: Social Issues (this additional course to be completed by Pediatrics residents only)

- UC Sexual Violence and Sexual Harassment Prevention Training for Supervisors and Faculty (every 2 years)
- UC Cyber Security Awareness Fundamentals
- Advance HIPAA Healthcare Provider

- CRMC (required annually)– Bloodborne Pathogens: Protecting Against Transmission
