1. Open your web browser (safari, chrome, etc.)
2. Search for Zoom

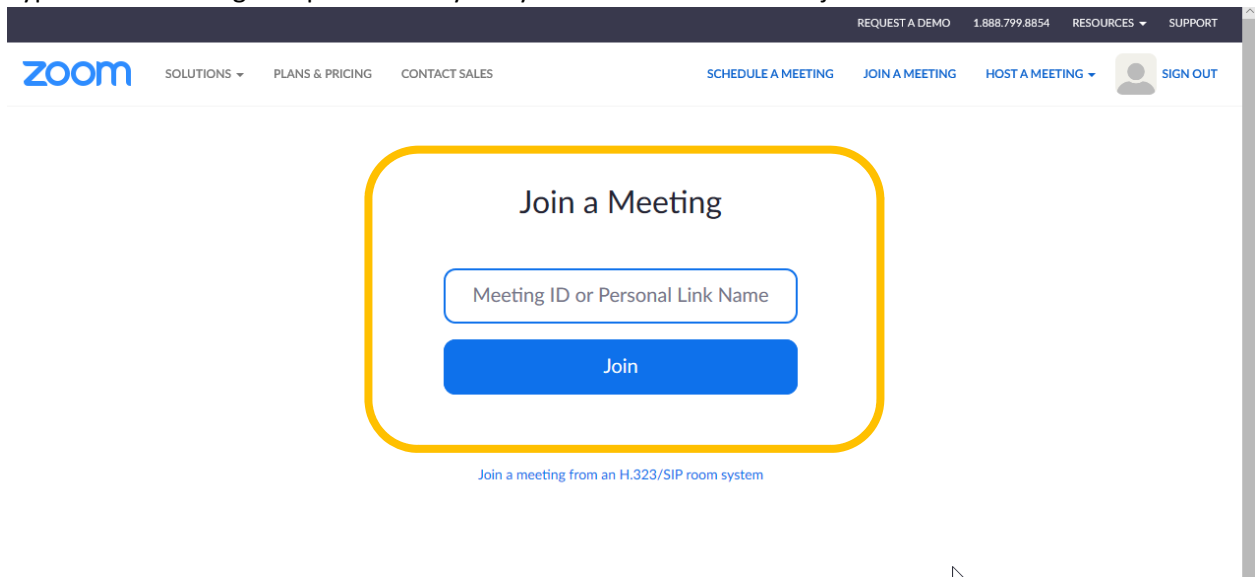

3. Click on Zoom- Video Conferencing... and click on “Join a meeting”

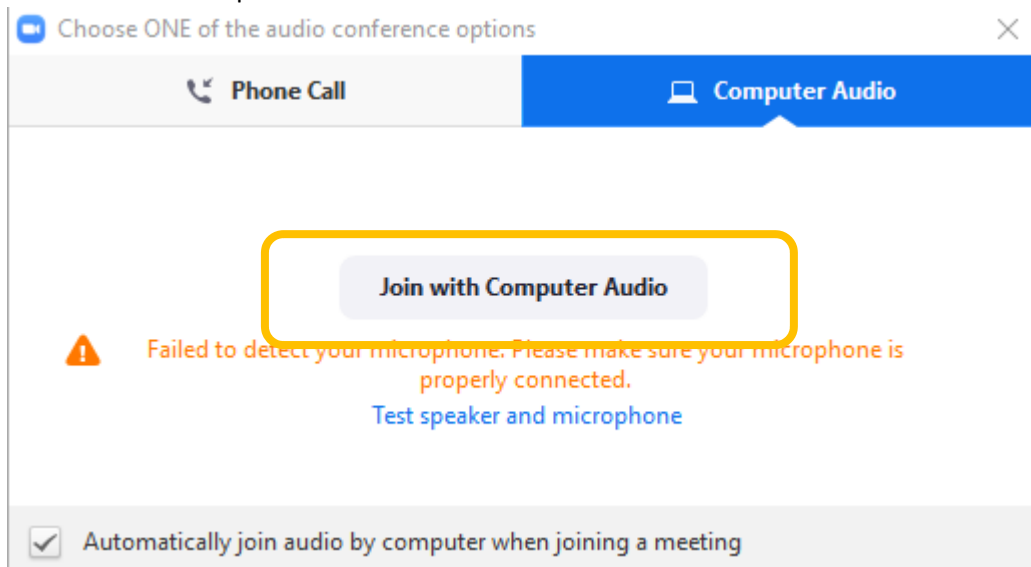
