

CO-DIRECTORS OF SIMULATION JOB DESCRIPTION UCSF Fresno

Under the direction of the Assistant Deans of Undergraduate Medical Education and Graduate medical Education, the Medical Directors will lead the UCSF Fresno Clinical Skills and Simulation Center, defining its mission and guiding its teaching and research goals.

Qualifications:

- Full-time UCSF Fresno faculty member in good standing
- Demonstrated experience in simulation
- Teaching experience in an academic environment at the medical student level
- Experience developing and evaluating curricula
- Experience assessing learners

Responsibilities:

- Provides effective leadership of the UCSF Fresno Clinical Skills Lab and Simulation Center and staff members. In collaboration with undergraduate and graduate leadership, defines and directs the strategic vision and mission to guide the teaching and research.
- Provides curricular design and simulation expertise as well as content expertise, when appropriate, in the development and implementation of simulation activities to support the UCSF Fresno undergraduate and graduate medical education programs.
- Contributes to the assessment of student development and readiness for promotion.
- Oversees the budget of the simulation lab including the purchasing and maintenance of equipment
- Acts as liaison with faculty, advisors, administrators and staff from the university, clinical partners, outreach and external agencies.

Report Relations:

The Simulation Directors report to UCSF Fresno Assistant Deans of Undergraduate Medical Education and Graduate Medical Education.
